

## Security Tip for the Month

On June 7 at the Clubhouse, Officer Tony Burkhardt, our neighborhood police Denver officer (NPO), spoke to a large turnout of Stoney Brook residents. His recommendations:

- Lock all doors all the time. Security doors front and back if possible. Patio doors need deadbolts into frame of door; sliding glass doors need to be blocked with a broomstick or something similar so they cannot be jiggled open.
- Burglar alarms are a must and should be armed at all times.
- Lights: front and patio lights should be on all night. Motion detector lights are an excellent option, especially on patios.
- Garage doors should be closed at all times. Good idea to leave a key with a neighbor in case left open accidentally.
- When home, turn on lights radio/TV. Let people know you are there.
- When away on vacation, use timers on lights and radio/TV.
- Built in safe for valuables.
- Neighbors need to be aware and alert to what is going on in their area. Notify Stoney Brook office of strange cars and note the license number.
